PJ Dick provided Construction Management services for renovations and upgrades to 44,180 sf of this historical landmark. Much of the interior is paneled and floored with Georgian and Italian marble. The roof is terra cotta tile and the dome is sheathed in copper with a stained glass rotunda. In addition to all new building mechanical and electrical systems, work included renovation of two existing courtrooms and the addition of a third, installation of ADA elevator and chair lift, upgrades to office spaces, and installation of a new sound system in the courtrooms. All work was performed while the courthouse remained open and operational.
